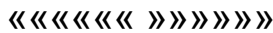


Boston University invites applications from candidates for a full-time **Lecturer and Clinical Instructor** position in its **Criminal Law Clinical Program** (the “Program”).

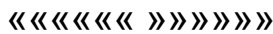
