

## South Asian Bar Association of Greater Boston (SABA Greater Boston) Legal Intern Fellowship Fact Sheet

Applications must be received by May 15, 2022.

#### The South Asian Bar Association of Greater Boston

Founded in 2004, SABA Greater Boston is the local chapter of the South Asian Bar Association of North America. In addition to serving as the regional voice for the concerns and opinions of South Asians in the community generally and in the legal profession in particular, our mission includes promoting the advancement and development of attorneys and law students of South Asian heritage.

SABA Greater Boston is therefore proud to announce its 2022 annual Legal Intern Fellowship Program. The program is intended to provide funding in an amount up to \$5,000 for either law students of South Asian descent working over the summer in otherwise unpaid legal positions at non-profit or government organizations or law students working in an unpaid legal internship focusing on the needs of BIPOC/LGBTQ communities.

#### Requirements

SABA Greater Boston encourages law students who have secured a volunteer internship as discussed above with a nonprofit or government organization within the Greater Boston area to apply to the program. Applicants must be enrolled for the 2022-2023 academic year (but not be graduating in May or June 2022) and in good standing in a U.S. law school. Volunteer internships must be full-time for at least ten weeks. The internship must provide the law student with substantial legal experience.

#### **Selection Process**

Members of the Board of SABA Greater Boston will review all applications and select recipients. If necessary, finalists may be interviewed by one or more members of the Board. Recipients will be selected no later than May 29, 2022. The Fellowship winner will be invited to and asked to speak about their experiences at the SABA GB Annual Gala & Awards Dinner.

#### How to Apply

A prospective applicant must send:

- 1. Application Form and Certification
- 2. Resume
- 3. Official Law School Transcript
- 4. One Letter of Reference From a Former Employer or Law School Professor
